

KIDTIX CHAPERONES

*** * * BEFORE THE THEATER * * ***

- **The KidTix Program offers students the opportunity to attend a professional, fully produced dance performance by BalletMet. BalletMet offers recommendations as to which performances are suitable for different ages of students. Not all performances are suitable for all ages of students. Please be sure to check with BalletMet about its recommendations for age-appropriate viewing. Chaperones who attend the performance must make childcare arrangements for their preschoolers, toddlers and/or infants.**
- **BalletMet's Education Department has provided you with material to prepare your student group for performance viewing. We ask that you use this material prior to the performance to ensure proper theatre etiquette and better understanding and integration of the experience with your students' existing culture.**

*** * AT THE THEATER * * ***

- The doors open 30 minutes prior to each performance time. Students and chaperones are asked to dress appropriately for theatre attendance. Dress should be similar to that of clothing worn to religious services or a celebratory event.
- Ushers are in charge of seating and your cooperation is appreciated. **Seat location is pre-assigned to enable groups to be seated together.**
- For expediency, please allow your group to be seated quickly by the ushers. Adults should be seated as well as children; the ushers do not need assistance. **Once your entire group has been seated, you may re-arrange students and chaperones within your assigned block of seats. It is recommended that chaperones be interspersed among the students.**
- **No food or drink is permitted** in the theater.
- **Absolutely no photographs or videos may be taken during the performance due to contractual restrictions and for the safety of the dancers. This includes photographs and videos taken with phones.** While awaiting the show, noise must be kept to a minimum and touring of the theater is not permitted.
